

MAI AYSIAN **PHILHARMONIC ORCHESTRA**

The Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO) gave its inaugural performance at Dewan Filharmonik PETRONAS (DFP) on 17 August 1998. With the initial search for outstanding musicians involving a worldwide audition tour, the MPO today is made up of many talented Malaysian musicians and musicians from other nations, a beautiful example of harmony among different cultures and nationalities.

With each new season, the MPO continues to present an exciting programme of orchestral music drawn from over three centuries, as well as the crowd-pleasing concert series. Its versatility transcends genres, from classical masterpieces to film music, pop. jazz, traditional, contemporary and commissioned works.

Among renowned Malaysian artists who have mesmerized audiences with the MPO include SM Salim, Sheila Majid, M.Nasir, Siti Nurhaliza, Jamal Abdillah, Ella, Dayang Nurfaizah, Aishah, Jaclyn Victor and Aubrey Suwito.

A host of internationally acclaimed musicians have performed with the MPO including Lorin Maazel, Sir Neville Marriner, Yehudi Menuhin, Joshua Bell, Harry Connick Jr., José Carreras, Andrea Bocelli, Dame Kiri Te Kanawa, Vladimir Ashkenazy, Chris Botti, Branford Marsalis and Judika, many of whom have praised the MPO for its fine musical qualities and vitality.

The MPO regularly performs in major cities of Malaysia such as in Alor Setar, George Town, Ipoh, Johor Bahru, Kuantan, Kota Kinabalu, Kuching and many more. Internationally, it has toured Singapore (1999, 2001, 2003, 2005 and 2018), Japan (2001, 2009 and 2017), Korea (2001), Australia (2004), China (2006 and 2019), Taiwan (2007) and Vietnam (2013). The MPO has also released 21 CDs.

The MPO remains steadfast in its mission to be the premier Malaysian orchestra, providing the ultimate music experience through the power of live music that educates, entertains and inspires. Its main benefactor is PETRONAS, and its patron is YABhg. Tun Dr. Siti Hasmah Haji Mohd Ali.

Born in Hong Kong, Francis Kan learnt music during childhood and it has become an integral part of his life.

After graduating from the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts in 1993, he continued his studies at the Guildhall School of Music in London with a full scholarship. Recommended by maestro Sergio Commissiona, he was appointed as a conducting intern of the Asian Youth Orchestra, with whom he toured to Hong Kong, Singapore and the USA.

In 1995, Kan won the International Competition for Young Conductors in Portugal and since then, has conducted several orchestras abroad including the Lisbon Metropolitan Orchestra. Romanian National Radio Orchestra, Bucharest Philharmonic and Silvestri Chamber Orchestra.

Kan has also conducted the Hong Kong Sinfonietta, City Chamber Orchestra of Hong Kong and Pan Asia Symphony Orchestra, and was the Principal Conductor of the Union Philharmonic Orchestra, HKUSU, since its inception until 2013.

From 2006 to 2023, Kan was the Assistant Conductor of Macao Orchestra. From 2010 to 2012, he became Resident Conductor at the Guiyang Symphony Orchestra. He frequently collaborated with the China National Centre for the Performing Arts Orchestra and Harbin Symphony Orchestra. In 2015, he led the Shenzhen Symphony Orchestra on a cultural exchange performance to South Africa and conducted the opening concert for the 'Year of China', which was highly praised by Luo Shugang, the Minister of Culture of the People's Republic of China. That year, he also toured to Europe (Zurich and Budapest) with the Macao Orchestra and pianist Zhang Haochen.

Kan was the conductor of A Dream of Fragrancy, a local original chamber opera in three acts composed by Liu Chenchen at the 30th Macao International Music Festival in 2016. In 2017, Kan performed with the National Ballet of China Symphony Orchestra at The National Centre for the Performing Arts in Beijing commemorating the 20th anniversary of Hong Kong's handover to China. In 2018, he led the Zhejiang Symphony Orchestra on a tour to Brazil.



Tan Soo Suan is a veteran, award winning artist and resident singer of Dama Asia, a Malaysian bilingual theatre company. Besides Malaysia, she has performed in Australia, Indonesia, Singapore, Hong Kong, China, Taiwan, Canada and the USA.

Soo Suan was awarded the local National Grand Champion of Classical Singing in 1998, after having won the competition for three consecutive years. She is also a recipient of Boh Cameronian Arts Award for Best Vocal Performance and Best Musical Actress Award.

Soo Suan has several recordings including Memories, Fragrance of The Night, September Tale, The Moon Speaks For My Heart, Butterfly Lovers, Empress Wu and Bu Liao Qing Ren.

Her rendition of Eternally was featured in Tsai Ming-Liang's film, I Don't Want To Sleep Alone, premiered at the Venice International Film Festival 2006.

Her stage credits included The Songs In Me, Portrait Of A Songstress, In The Imperial Garden, Fragrance Of The Night, Spring Kisses Lover's Tears, A Musical Sojourn, Love Without End, Memories, Le Cabaret Shanghai, September Tale, Butterfly Lovers - The Musical, I Have A Date With Spring - The Musical, In Perfect Harmony, Glitz & Glamour, Moon Speaks For My Heart, Empress Wu - The Musical, The Legends, Larger Than Life, Yours Musicals, Evergreen, In Celebration and Delicate Dreams & Desires.



Hailing from Kuantan, Pahang, Amy Chan began her musical journey in the late 1980s and released over ten albums. She gradually stepped away from the public eye in the late 1990s.

In 2015, she reignited her passion for singing by participating in Astro Classic Golden Melody. This competition allowed her to rediscover the boundless charm of music and fuelled her determination to return to the stage. Since then, she participated in TV programmes, 'live' broadcasts, cooking shows, reality programme, and served as a judge for Astro's talent shows. She released three albums and held solo concerts.

In 2023, Amy participated in a singing competition called TVB's Voice of the Middle Ages 2 in Hong Kong, and advanced into the Top 20. This competition exposed her to new dynamics on stage, offering fresh musical inspiration and valuable life insights.

In 2024, she shifted her focus to charitable endeavours, organising charity concerts, donating to Chinese schools and supporting single mothers, giving back to society through her music.



Lim Yong Huat has always been passionate about singing, a love he could never let go of despite life's challenges. Born in Bagan Datuk, Perak, he was inspired by his mother's love for music and took part in singing competitions from a very young age. His desire to perform grew stronger as he participated in many singing competitions.

After moving to Kuala Lumpur, Lim participated in competitions including Astro Star Quest in 1997; he was eliminated during the auditions. He quit performing on stage for over a decade and focused on his family and career instead.

Lim's turning point came when his late father told him, "A person named Ah Huat will never be unsuccessful". These words stayed with him, and at 45, Lim pursued his passion again when he competed in Astro Classic Golden Melody in 2018 and became the champion.



Kaho Loh is an experienced singer with over 10 years of performance experience. Besides Malaysia, his musical journey has taken him to various countries including the USA, China, Hong Kong, Singapore, Taiwan, Indonesia, Thailand and Brunei, leaving a footprint in performances around the world.

His musical style is diverse as he excels in singing in Cantonese, Mandarin, English and Malay with a particular familiarity with classic hits from the 1980s, 1990s and 2000s. His repertoire includes songs by renowned singers including Jacky Cheung, Leslie Cheung, Sam Hui, Anita Mui, Eason Chan, Alan Tam, Emile Chou, Wang Jie, Jeff Chang, Jay Chou and Qi Qin.

His performances are not limited to solo singing; he often participates in wedding receptions and corporate events, enjoying widespread popularity.

Loh also serves as a backing vocalist for the concerts of superstars including Wang Jie. Xin Xiao Qi, Wang Ming Quan, Zheng Shao Qiu and Ke Yi Min. He loves bringing joy to the audience and excels at creating a lively atmosphere, often leading the entire audience in sing-alongs, making him a highlight of the performances.

Recently, he became the finalist in the ASTRO Classic Songs Singing Competition. This has further solidified his position in the music industry and introduced him to a wider audience.

PROGRAMME NOTES

In this special concert, the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO) takes the audience down memory lane with Hong Kong classics from the golden era of its entertainment industry in the 1980s and 1990s, which was filled with long-standing TV series, box-office films and unforgettable tunes from these shows.

It was a time in which TVB, the dominant television network in Hong Kong, experienced tremendous growth and created many iconic dramas which were hugely popular not only in Hong Kong but across other parts of Asia. Some of the most notable series were The Bund and The Legend of the Condor Heroes.

Along these TV series came well-known stars such as Chow Yun-Fat, Andy Lau, Tony Leung Chiu Wai and Carina Lau, among others, who made their mark on TV before having successful film careers later.

More than 40 years after the boom of the industry, these TV series, films, songs and the stars are still part of the life of so many people who grew up with them and this evening, the MPO will take fans back to these nostalgic moments, proving yet again, the orchestra's versatility in conveying the varied stories of life through orchestral music.

To be conducted by Francis Kan, the MPO will collaborate with vocalists Tan Soo Suan, Amy Chan, Lim Yong Huat and Loh Ka Ho on vocals, get ready to relive your favourite TV series through compositions masterfully arranged for this concert.

Some of the country's respected arrangers have lent their expertise and musical finesse to reinterpret these songs and give them fresh, orchestral arrangements:

Gerard Salonga arranges three songs, all from the TV series The Bund, a Hong Kong period crime TV series aired in the 1980s and dubbed "The Godfather Of The East". Salonga's arrangements of Main Theme, Myriad Emotions and Dragon and Tiger Duel will bring back fond memories of this series that spawned two sequels, two remakes and even a film adaptation.

Wong Jun Xian contributes four arrangements. namely Overture and Boundless Oceans, Vast Skies, the latter made popular by Hong Kong pop group Beyond. Wong also arranges two songs from the famed 1980s TV series The Legend of the Condor Heroes: Iron Blood and Loyal Heart, a song originally sung as a duet by Roman Tam and Jenny Tseng, and You Are The Best In The World, which appeared in the third season of the 59-episode show.





Meanwhile, arranger and violinist Azhad Sulaiman contributes his arranging expertise for Love And Passion from the Hong Kong TV series Love and Passion, an epic 1930s war melodrama with painful love triangles and complicated romance. Azhad also arranges Fatal Irony, from the 1974 TV series of the same name, adapted from Fate in Tears and Laughter, a 1930 Chinese novel by Zhang Henshui,

Musician Ilham Subri gives a fresh take for songs such as Beautiful Shadow, composed by Kenneth Choi in 1981, which won an award at the 1981 RTHK Top 10 Gold Songs Awards. Ilham also arranges Lament of Life's Lessons, sung by Sam Hui. Loving Just You, popularised by Danny Chan and Twin Stars Love Song from the 1974 comedic film Game Gamblers Play.

Lugman Aziz contributes his arrangement for Forgotten in the Mist from the TV series The Demi-Gods & Semi-Devils and Love in a Lifetime, from A Chinese Odyssev Part Two: Cinderella, starring Stephen Chow, famous for his stunts and comic timing.

Jenny Chin gives new, symphonic interpretations to Love Warms My Heart/ Love Warms In The Heart from the TV series The Misadventures of Zoo, and Stealing the Heart with Love, the theme song from the TV series The Shell Game by illustrated composer Joseph Koo.

From the big and silver screens to the stage of DFP, these compositions have been meticulously arranged and uplifted for a live concert audience, refreshing their sounds and feel to ignite nostalgia and memories.




